September 9: Board your deluxe motorcoach and set off for **LeClaire, Iowa**, where your journey begins. Enjoy free time to explore this charming river town, including a visit to **Antique Archaeology**, the home base of the American Pickers television show. Later, check in to the Holiday Inn Express Riverfront before heading out for an included dinner at the **Crane & Pelican Café**. Nestled in a historic River Pilot home overlooking the Mississippi River, the Crane & Pelican offers a warm and inviting dining experience, featuring inspired, home-style recipes and a glimpse into LeClaire's rich riverfront history.

September 10: Board the **Riverboat Twilight**, featuring three decks with comfortable dining salons and sundecks with lounge chairs for those who wish to sightsee or relax in the sun. An expanded continental breakfast will be waiting for us before we depart north on our scenic journey along the **Mississippi River**. In addition to beautiful views and delicious meals, the captain will narrate stories of the river's wildlife, valley landscapes, and historic towns along the way. Enjoy live entertainment, games, snacks, humor, and folklore as we cruise toward historic **Dubuque, Iowa**. Tonight's accommodations are at the boutique **Hotel Julien**, where your luggage will be waiting in your room. The evening is yours to explore the city as you wish. Once home to a thriving warehouse industry, Dubuque is rich in history and charm. You might ride the Fenelon Place Elevator, the world's shortest and steepest railway, for a magnificent view of the historic district, the Mississippi River, and three states beyond.

September 11: Start your day with an included hot plated breakfast at the hotel before spending the morning exploring Dubuque's rich history, architecture, shops, and attractions. Continuous complimentary shuttle service will be available from the hotel lobby to popular Port of Dubuque destinations. Shuttle stops include Iowa's #1 attraction, the Smithsonian-accredited **National Mississippi River Museum & Aquarium** (admission included), the 4th Street Elevator, Cable Car Square Shopping Center, St. Luke's Methodist Church with its stunning Tiffany stained-glass windows, and the Diamond Jo Casino. Reboard the Riverboat Twilight at 10:45 a.m. and begin your relaxing return journey south. Take in the sights and listen to any of the captain's narration you may have missed on Day 1. Lunch and dinner will be served onboard as we cruise back to LeClaire. Check back into the Holiday Inn Express for another comfortable overnight stay and enjoy a relaxing, free evening at your leisure.

September 12: After an included breakfast we will depart for **Starved Rock State Park**, on our return home. Starved Rock State Park on the Illinois River bluff in LaSalle County is one of Illinois' most beautiful destinations. Experience a guided trolley tour, time at the Visitor's Center, and an included lunch before continuing home.
