

Day 1, Saturday - June 6

Day 2, Sunday - June 7

(West Yarmouth)

Enjoy an included breakfast at your hotel. Your hotel for tonight is the Hampton Inn, West Yarmouth, MA. Your property features a fitness center, indoor and outdoor pools, indoor hot tub, and lobby bar to enjoy in the evenings. Lobster dinner is included this evening.

Day 3. Monday - June 8

(Nantucket Island)

After a hearty breakfast buffet, you will depart for Hyannis. Sail on the Hy-Line High Speed Ferry to Nantucket Island. Your cruise is approximately 1 hour. The island looks much as it did during its heyday as a prosperous whaling and shipping port of the 1800's with cedar shingled homes and elegant whaling mansions lining the cobblestone streets. Upon arrival you will have free time to explore the upscale boutiques, gift shops, museums and art galleries downtown. Lunch will be on your own at one of the many restaurants in town. This afternoon board an island bus and tour across the island to the quaint village of Sconset. See cranberry bogs, rolling farmland, quiet villages and pounding surf. Return sailing from Nantucket to Hyannis is included prior to your dinner in Hyannis.

Day 4, Tuesday - June 9

(Cape Cod)

Following your included breakfast, depart with your local guide for touring to "land's end" Provincetown, at the tip of Cape Cod. Learn about cranberries, kettle ponds, "Half-Cape" architecture, sea captains and whaling, the "Graveyard of Ships" and more. Included is a rest stop at the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitor's Center. Free time for lunch on your own in Provincetown, a diverse community with a long history as a fishing port and a haven for well known artists. This afternoon you have a choice of either Whale Watching, try and spot Humpback, Minke, and Fin Whales going about their daily business or experience a fun and informative driving tour across the magnificent dunes of the National Seashore Park. Learn about the history of life saving stations and dune shacks while enjoying the endless mountains of sand (vehicles are enclosed 4 wheel drive SUV's). This evening dinner will be at a local restaurant.

Day 5, Wednesday - June 10

(Martha's Vineyard)

After a hearty breakfast, tour Woods Hole prior to departing for Martha's Vineyard. Your local guide accompanies you throughout the day. Upon arrival on Martha's Vineyard, you will enjoy a complete island tour on your motorcoach, including the colorful "Gingerbread Cottages" in Oak Bluffs, followed by scenic touring along the ocean (see where "JAWS" was filmed!)
