#### Day 1: Overnight Flight

It's time to live the good life and embark on a getaway to the fabulous French Riviera, or *Côte d'Azur*. Its elegant coastal resorts, superb eateries, chic boutiques, and captivating museums make it the ultimate sunny retreat for the elite. Unpack your bags just once and stay at a single hotel for your entire adventure, which begins with an overnight flight to France.

#### Day 2: Nice (French Riviera), France

Your tour commences in the stunning city of Nice, a coastal pearl of the Mediterranean known for its legendary opulence and balmy beaches. With an average of 300 sunny days per year, Nice is a seaside paradise. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in *Vieux Nice* featuring Mediterranean-inspired French cuisine. *Today dinner will be included.*

#### Day 3: Nice

Get around like a local by navigating the tram this morning. Get familiar with the tramway routes to use to your advantage in your free time later. With a local expert, discover Nice by meandering through the city's famed and colorful flower market. Then, delve into the Old Town, sampling local delicacies while on a tasting tour. The rest of the day is yours. Perhaps you'll return to your hotel and stroll along the lively seafront *Promenade des Anglais*. You may even stay downtown and visit one of Nice's world-class art galleries, such as the Chagall or the Matisse museums. Maybe you'll find your favorite café for the week and soak in the local life. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

#### Day 4: Nice - Monaco - Nice

Travel along the spectacular *Corniche* coastal road to the Principality of Monaco. On a walking tour, view the changing of the guards and visit the Cathedral of Monaco — the permanent resting place of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace. Then **it's your choice!** Visit the Prince's Palace of Monaco to tour this grand residence **-OR-** hop on a "little train" tour,\* taking in Monaco's history and sights, including views of Monte Carlo Casino. *Today breakfast will be included.*

#### Day 5: Nice - Èze - Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat - Nice

Today, learn the secrets of perfume making during a hands-on workshop and tour of the Fragonard perfumery, where fragrant formulations have been prepared since 1782. Spend time soaking up the atmosphere of a *Provençal* hill town: the medieval village of Èze. Explore the village's timeless charm and the Exotic Garden of Èze. Then head to Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, referred to as the crown jewel of the French Riviera, before returning to Nice. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

#### Day 6: Nice - Cannes - Nice

Journey to Cannes and sail\*\* across the Bay of Cannes to the tiny island of Saint-Honorat, belonging to the monks of Lérins Abbey. Pause to taste the locally produced wine before returning to Cannes to perhaps rub elbows with Europe's elite. Walk in the footsteps of celebrities when you see the Film Festival Palace and the iconic red carpet featured during the Cannes Film Festival. During free time, explore the cobbled lanes of the *Le Suquet* neighborhood or the lively Forville farmers' market. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

#### Day 7: Nice - Optional Excursion to Italy

The day is yours! Enjoy your free time relaxing and taking in the laid-back atmosphere along the Riviera. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion that takes you to discover Dolceaqua, a gem of the Italian Riviera nestled in the mountains, before savoring the local cuisine during an included lunch. *Today breakfast will be included.*

#### Day 8: Nice - St. Paul de Vence - Nice

This morning, venture to historic St. Paul de Vence, situated atop a hill overlooking the beautiful countryside of Provence. Explore this walled medieval village, soaking in its distinctive light, said to have inspired Matisse, Braque, Chagall, and other artists. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner celebrating the end of an unforgettable trip. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

#### Day 9: Nice - Tour Ends

Depart for home with many wonderful memories of your journey through the *Cote d'Azur*. *Today breakfast will be included.*

## Experience It! Nice Flower Market

In the heart of *Vieux Nice* (Old Town), amongst old-world boutiques and petite cafés, you'll find the vibrant Nice Flower Market. This bustling market is located on Cours Saleya, the famous promenade in the old city. This favorite daily (except on Monday) stopover for locals and tourists alike features much more than flowers. Vendors tout an array of produce, flowers, and various other delicacies. It is a feast for the senses. Take in the fragrant aroma of fresh-cut flowers, sample seasonal fruits and fresh-baked breads, be dazzled by the bountiful colorful displays, sip and savor a hot cappuccino, take a moment to pause and chat with the locals, or listen to the romantic sounds of the French language being spoken all around you.

**Single-hotel Stays:** Unpack just once and explore the world's most iconic cities during Spotlights' single-hotel stays. The leisurely pace offers you the chance to get to know these destinations like a local. Must-see cultural highlights are always included, plus there's plenty of time to explore independently, creating your own unique adventure.

## Important Tour Information:

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

**The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3.** This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas such as the Old Town of Nice, Monaco, Saint-Honorat Island, and St. Paul de Vence. If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate tour with us. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Your visits to Monaco, the Gardens of Villa Rothschild, and St. Paul de Vence village involve negotiating some steep inclines over cobblestones, gravel, or multiple flights of steps.

\*The Little Train tour operates from February to mid-November. In the other months, travelers selecting this choice will transfer to the Monte Carlo district by public bus.

\*\*The Saint-Honorat Island cruise operates weather permitting, is dependent on sea conditions, and is only available from April to October. Tours from November through the end of March will visit an alternate winery.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

### IDENTIFICATION

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. ##### Day 9: Nice (French Riviera) - Paris

Head to the airport for your flight to the French capital. In under two hours, you'll be in Paris, the "City of Light." Depending on your flight arrival time, you may get a chance to explore your hotel's neighborhood with your Tour Manager, learn how to use *Le Métro* (the city's famed underground transport system) like a local, and explore the Notre Dame Cathedral neighborhood. Enjoy the rest of the evening at leisure.

##### Day 10: Paris

This morning, join your local expert and head back to *Le Métro* to get to the hip neighborhood of Montmartre. Blending artistic roots and quirky modernity, the 18th *arrondissement* is home to classical painters and cultural provocateurs. After trying a local café, take advantage of free time this afternoon to explore on your own. Perhaps you'll browse the shops of the *Opéra* district, where you'll have time to peruse luxury Parisian retailers, or take a stroll down the Champs-Élysées. As your day comes to a close, make the most of an evening at leisure. If you'd prefer to do something with the group, you can join an optional dinner at the Paradis Latin\* for a can-can kicking, music-driven night at the cabaret. (B)

##### Day 11: Paris

It's your last day in Paris – how will you spend it? Perhaps you'll explore *Le Marais*, a trendy district with winding streets, gorgeous old mansions, and independent boutiques, or meander through Place des Vosges, the oldest planned town square in all of Paris. You can also choose to join an optional visit to the Suresnes American Cemetery in Paris, a memorial and resting place of more than 1,500 American servicemen and women from both World Wars. This evening, take in an exclusive view of Paris from the Montparnasse Tower while raising a glass of champagne to toast to the night. (B)

##### Day 12: Paris - Extension Ends

Wish Paris *au revoir* as your extension comes to an end. (B)

## Important Tour Extension Information:

**The overall activity level of this extension is a level 4.** This means you can handle longer walking tours (more than 90 minutes), traversing dusty or uneven terrain, standing for periods of time, varying altitudes and temperatures, and don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late-night experiences, and full days. Unfortunately, this level is not appropriate for individuals who use wheelchairs or walkers.

**Fully-guided** extensions are a great way to explore a new destination. Enjoy sightseeing and local experiences led by a Tour Manager or local expert.

We reserve the right to cancel this extension if a minimum of 7 travelers is not met to operate.

Extensions not purchased at time of deposit are subject to availability and applicable charges at time of request.

This extension does not use a bus for any of its inclusions, instead using the Paris subway system. This requires the ability to navigate 2 to 3 flights of stairs and agility to step on and off moving escalators. Seating is not guaranteed in the Métro as it's available on a first come, first served basis. In case seats are not available, the ability to stand in a moving vehicle is required (handrails are available). Most underground stations are not wheelchair accessible.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

\*Paradis Latin may be considered unsuitable for children - consult your Tour Manager.

If you intend to visit well-known tourist sites of Paris, like the Louvre Museum or the Eiffel Tower, we recommend that you purchase tickets a few months ahead.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Due to fair periods in Paris, the rate of this extension may be higher on certain dates. Please inquire about rates and availability at time of booking.
