Day 1: Overnight Flight

Travel along breathtaking landscapes and venture into metropolitan meccas ripe with culture and history. Discover Italy on an unforgettable journey that delves into its most cherished treasures.

Day 2: Stresa, Italy

Begin on the arresting shores of Lake Maggiore, surrounded by the peaceful beauty of the Alpine lakes region. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring independently and admiring the views. This evening, cruise to Isola Pescatori,* the most picturesque of the Borromean Islands, where you'll engage with new friends at a dinner welcoming you to Italy. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Stresa

During an **Impact Moment**, visit an ancient village nestled in the mountains, where a local family is actively working to preserve local traditions and historic buildings. After a tour of the village, they invite you to sample their very own artisanal cheeses, paired with the region's best wines. The remainder of the day in Stresa is at your leisure. Explore its piazzas, flower-lined cobblestone streets, and lakeside promenades. Or, enjoy your breathtaking surroundings during an optional cruise to Isola Bella, known as the "beautiful island." Here, an expert will guide you into the Borromeo Palace,** a lakeside Baroque beauty adorned with an enchanting garden. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 4: Stresa - Portofino - Chiavari, Italian Riviera

Journey to the Italian Riviera and discover its immeasurable grandeur along the Liguria coast. Spend some free time in the famous village of Portofino, known for its picturesque harbor and vibrant colors, and as a glamorous getaway spot and retreat for the jet set. Early this evening, arrive in Chiavari and settle in for your two-night stay in this charming coastal town. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 5: Chiavari - Cinque Terre

Travel by rail today as you discover the colorful Cinque Terre, a string of once-upon-a-time fishing villages, perched on the edge of the sea. Feel like you have stepped back in time as you traverse the rugged coastal area dotted with terraced vineyards and hop off to visit two of these fabled locales. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 6: Chiavari - Carrara Marble Quarries - Tuscany

Veer off the beaten path to visit one of Italy's natural wonders: the Carrara marble quarries. During an off-road drive in the Apuane Mountains, you'll follow the pathways carved by quarrymen while extracting the precious stone. Over the centuries, Carrara marble was used by artists such as Michelangelo to carve his legendary statue of *David*. Continue on through the rolling hills of Tuscany, ending the day in a historic Tuscan villa for a rejuvenating 4-night stay.*** *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 7: Tuscany - San Gimignano

This morning, journey into the heart of the Chianti countryside, where a family-owned villa welcomes you. After a tour of the house and grounds, engage in a hands-on cooking lesson. Break bread during an authentic Tuscan lunch and toast to your host with local Chianti wine. Then, take in Tuscany's landscape, a spectrum of verdant vineyards and endless groves en route to San Gimignano. Nicknamed the Manhattan of the Middle Ages, San Gimignano's 14 towers soar distinctively over the landscape, making this iconic hilltop village stand out against the rolling hills. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 8: Tuscany - Florence

Welcome to Florence – the birthplace of the Renaissance and the beloved home of the Medici family, Galileo, Botticelli, and da Vinci. Set out on a walking tour of Florence's

treasures and monuments, highlighting the *Piazza del Duomo* and the famous Gates of Paradise on the Baptistery. You'll also wander past the *Palazzo Vecchio*, the Signoria and Santa Croce squares. Enjoy some time to explore Florence independently before returning to your villa in the early evening. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 9: Tuscany

Spend a relaxing day of *dolce far-niente* (sweet do-nothing) at your Tuscan villa. Stroll the surrounding countryside or just take in the views from your favorite spot in the garden. Or, embark on an optional truffle hunt, led by a local expert and trained truffle-sniffing dogs. As you wander along unpaved trails, learn about the fascinating world of truffles and the techniques used to forage them. Indulge in a truffle-themed lunch before returning to your villa in the late afternoon. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 10: Tuscany - Venice

A morning transfer takes you from Tuscany to the Emilia region for a visit to a family-owned *acetaia*. Tour the attic, where balsamic vinegar has been produced for five generations, and discover this generational process, which spans 12 to 25 years. Enjoy a light lunch infused with balsamic vinegar, before continuing to Venice, the “Queen of the Adriatic,” for a two-night stay in one of the world’s most romantic cities. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 11: Venice

Spend the day in *Venezia*, the floating city home to lavish art collections, wonders of architecture, and where marbled palaces tower over gondola-laden canals. A local guide takes you on a walking tour of its incredible sites, including the Bridge of Sighs, the Bell tower, and St. Mark’s Square. Then, travel by boat to Murano**** for an expert glass-blowing demonstration, a renowned tradition on the island. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure to explore more of Venice on your own. Consider an optional gondola cruise to experience Venice’s most famous pastime. This evening, say *arrivederci* to Italy at a savory farewell dinner. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 12: Venice - Tour Ends

Wake up in Venice and depart for home. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Experience It! The Carrara Marble Quarries

Climb into the seat of an off-road vehicle to climb high into the Apuane mountains, a small chain overlooking the Mediterranean. There, you'll find the brilliant white quarries where Carrara marble is mined. These legendary quarries have supplied the world with marble since the era of the early Romans, who used it to build ancient architecture like the Pantheon. Later, renown artists like Michelangelo and Rodin would use this marble to carve their masterpieces. *Cavatori*, or quarrymen, have been pulling marble from these mountains for 2000 years. But it's not just the art and the architecture made from this marble that will take your breath away – it's the landscape too. These are mountains of marble, and you can see the bright white veins running through the rock. The brilliance of the marble quarry against the blue of the sky and the sea is a sight you'll never forget.

Explorations: These small group tours give travelers access to the world in a truly authentic way. On these active, immersive journeys, travelers connect with the cultures of the world on a deeper, more meaningful level in ways that are hard to replicate. The group size is kept small, allowing these journeys to be the most active, engaging, and rewarding experience possible.

public transportation strikes. Seating cannot be reserved. Ferry boats are boarded via gangways with handrails.

Italy imposes strict limits on tour bus circulation and mandatory drop-off and pick-up points, especially in historic or protected areas such as Stresa, Portofino, Cinque Terre, San Gimignano, and Florence. Venice is entirely pedestrianized and only accessible by motorboat. All these areas require navigating large crowds, extensive walking over cobblestones, uneven and often narrow sidewalks, and occasionally unpaved terrain with loose gravel.

In Florence, you must be prepared to walk a minimum of 2.7 miles. From the bus drop-off point onwards, the tour is entirely on foot, involving up to 4 hours of walking and standing with only one restroom stop. There is no seating available, and the areas are crowded with cobblestone streets and narrow sidewalks.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, walkers, or Zimmer-frames.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

In order to fully experience the destination, some of our hotels on these tours are located in smaller towns or on country roads where access is limited to large coaches. In these cases, you will be dropped off as close as possible and there will be a short walk to access the hotel from the drop-off area.

Most shops and businesses in Italy are closed on Sundays and on national/religious holidays.

Days of features are interchangeable.

***Isola Bella and the Borromeo Palace & Gardens are open from March 15 to October 31 (though there are small differences every year based on when the closest weekend falls). If you are traveling between November 1 and March 14, you will enjoy a scenic cruise of the Borromeo Islands and a visit to Pallanza village instead. If you are in Lake Maggiore between March 15 and April 15, the Borromeo Palace might be closed mid-week.

You should expect large crowds in Cinque Terre, Portofino, San Gimignano, Florence, and Venice.

*In the event of adverse weather conditions, the dinner at Isola dei Pescatori may be held at your hotel instead.

****On occasion, due to inclement weather, your boat trip to Murano Island may be substituted with a visit to a local glass factory in Venice.

Most museums in Florence are closed on Mondays, including the Academy Gallery and the Uffizi, as are other state museums. Most state museums in Florence require reservations to access. We suggest you reserve your ticket online prior to departure if you plan to visit the Academy or the Uffizi during your free time in Florence.

Modest dress (covering your knees and shoulders for women and long trousers for men) is required when visiting religious sites, sanctuaries, basilicas, etc.

***Villas in Tuscany are dotted throughout the region, and we might use different properties on this tour. Some may be located in the countryside, removed from the city center. Others may be closer to the hustle and bustle of the region. Each one is unique, full of history, has many amenities, and is brimming with true Tuscan flavor. This is part of the fun!

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

When reserving single accommodations, be advised that single rooms in Italy are smaller in size and beds are usually cot-sized.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Smaller buses, which may not be lavatory equipped, may be used on this tour. In this case, frequent stops are made during travel periods.

Our departure transfers will depart from Venice city center to the Venice airport.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Our air travelers will arrive into Milan airport and depart out of Venice airport.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. Day 1: Overnight Flight

You are on your way to the elegant palazzos of regal Turin and the rolling hills of Piedmont, known for its world-class wines.

Day 2: Turin, Italy

Arrive today in Turin, the first capital of unified Italy, and settle in for your two-night stay. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today, though a local host will be at your hotel to provide you with information and an orientation of the area. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Dinner tonight is on your own.

Day 3: Turin - Piedmont Wine Country Excursion

Today, weave your way through Piedmont's wine country in the company of an expert guide. Locally called *Langhe*, this area combines gentle, vineyard-clad hills with quaint villages and the occasional castle dotting the landscape. Stop at Grinzane and take a stroll through the vineyards surrounding this historic castle, now home to the regional *enoteca* — a place dedicated to preserving and showcasing the best wines from the area. Later, visit a charming hilltop village and a local winery, where you'll tour the cellars and savor a selection of typical *Langhe* wines, including the renowned Barolo. Your visit concludes with a traditional *merenda*, a light meal of charcuterie and local cheeses, before returning to Turin in the early afternoon. The rest of the day is yours to further explore Turin on your own. (B)

Day 4: Turin - Lake Maggiore

Walk through Turin with an expert guide, uncovering a blend of French and Italian heritage. Discover the city's gluttonous side as you savor its famous *gianduiotti* chocolates and try a *bicerin* — a mix of espresso and chocolate — in one of the city's cafés, reminiscent of Parisian coffee spots. This afternoon, bid farewell to Turin as you transfer to Lake Maggiore* and begin your main tour. (B)

Important Tour Extension Information:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Day 12: Venice

Continue your exploration of Italy with a two-night stay in Venice, the "Queen of the Adriatic." From your centrally located hotel, start an in-depth visit of the vibrant center of this city with your local guide. The afternoon and evening are yours to enjoy independently.

Day 13: Venice

Enjoy a full day to explore Venice at your leisure. You can meander through the historic streets, taking in the city's unique architecture and gondola-filled canals. Maybe you'll decide to sample the local cuisine at a typical *bacaro* (a small wine bar), where locals stop for a glass of wine – traditionally called *ombra* – and small bites, which Venetians call *cicchetti*. Or take a local public waterbus ride to the nearby island of San Giorgio, which offers spectacular views of St. Mark's Square and the Doge's Palace. (B)

Day 14: Venice

Say *arrivederci* to Venice as your extension comes to an end today. You may arrange for your transfer to the airport through the hotel. (B)
